Archery Range Rules

Approved August 2021

- 1. Share the range.
- 2. All shooting archers should shoot from the same line. If using the elevated platform to shoot from there should not be any other shooters on the ground in front of the platform.
- 3. No Broadheads on wood enclosed Block targets. Broadheads can be used on personal targets.
- 4. When trap house 1 located immediately adjacent to the archery range is in use, do not go downrange beyond the farthest Block target or approximately 50 yards downrange of the shooting platform. Looking for lost arrows downrange of the farthest Block target should not done while trap house 1 is in use. Communication is necessary between archery range user and the trap organizers to ensure smooth and safe use of the range when trap house 1 is in use.
- 5. Lighting is available for use to extend use of the range when natural light is no sufficient. There is a 30-minute timer switch located on the back side of the shooting platform that turns the lights on. The timer is intended to keep the lights inadvertently being left on. Feel free to aim the lighting to the shooter's preference.
