CASE STUDY NON-PROFITS

ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE



It has been well studied that disadvantaged communities are often the most harshly impacted by environmental injustices. Examples might include increased cancer rates in a Black community because of factories that poison the air, or low-income communities being trapped in food deserts or food swamps. If your non-profit is working tirelessly to right these wrongs, Biome PHS can and will stand with you.

STEPS TO JUSTICE

AMPLIFY VOICES

Historically underserved communities have been historically ignored, including about the placement of locally undesirable land uses (LULUs). Campaigns like NIMBY (Not in my Backyard) have kept LULUs out of well-off neighborhoods, and disproportionately landed them in BIPOC communities.

LOBBYING AND EDUCATION

Non-profits have successfully used their platforms to lobby for these communities, and they have had some big wins. Biome PHS can continue and expand that effort, while educating policy makers and community leaders about the issues.

BRINGING NATURE TO URBAN AREAS

Lack of access to nature is itself an injustice. Planting community gardens or adding trees to urban areas can make a large impact on health and well-being.
