PARENT TAKE-HOME DEVOTION SHEET

Title: Your Worship Is Your Gift

Scripture: “Thanks be unto God for his unspeakable gift.” — 2 Corinthians 9:15 (KJV)

DEVOTION REFLECTION

God gave us the greatest gift ever — Jesus. Nobody on earth could ever repay that, match that, or equal that. But God didn’t ask us to. God wants something far more powerful than money, props, outfits, or perfect talent... God wants our worship and our heart behind it. The Little Drummer Boy didn’t have gold. He didn’t have expensive gifts or fancy resources. He had rhythm. And he gave THAT. That is what made it holy.

Sometimes we think what we have isn’t enough. Sometimes we compare ourselves to others. But God never compares what you have to what someone else has — He looks at the heart behind what YOU bring. Your gift matters. Your praise matters. Your obedience matters.

Your child today learned that their gift is valuable to God.

- Not because it’s big.
- Not because it’s shiny.
- But because it came from their heart.
