

POOL TOURNAMENT ELIGIBILITY

VNEA (VALLEY NATIONAL EIGHT BALL ASSOCIATION) & MOMA

Longest Running State Tournament

- 1. All players must have a minimum 32 games in no less than 8 weeks of league play in the current league season.
- 2. A Team may draft up to two (2) players from the same league system.
- 3. All players must be current members of a MOMA sponsored league.
- 4. Master/AA Division can consist of any 5 players from the same league system and will be handicapped. (4 players in the Women's Master/AA Division).
- 5. No Master players are permitted on "A" Division teams.
- 6. A Team may have one (1) player on the team who is ranked one division higher than the division you are playing in. For example: one (1) "AA" Division player on an "A" Division team is permitted.

Sub Rule: Each team may use up to two (2) substitutes to be entered into the team's match line-up prior to the start of play. No player should play any other player more than once unless there is a tie. In the event of a tie: select a player from each team, flip for the break, and winner wins the match.

All players finishing 4th place or better at any Open State, National, or Casino Pool Tournament within the last three years will be considered a "Master" player at the discretion of the tournament committee.

All players entering MOMA events will be required to disclose this information. Failure to do so will result in disqualification and a 2-year ban from all MOMA events!

Game Formats for Team Events:

Open Masters/AA = 25 games Open A & B = 20 games Women's AA & A = 16 games

All divisions are a Race to Points. Ties will be determined by choosing one player from each team, flip for break, and winner wins the match.
