



As a woman entrepreneur living in Mexico, the path to success is anything but clear, in fact one could argue that it is in fact riddled with challenges. In order to find success, women have to be extra resilient, vigilant and have an unwavering commitment to their business. This of course requires plenty of sacrifices along the way. Here in Mexico, the existence of a glass ceiling in the corporate world has been well documented and one could point out that much is being done to address the same. The same however can't be said about the many barriers women entrepreneurs experience when looking to start their own business.

Whether it's access to financing, training or simply childcare support, these are a few of the many challenges women entrepreneurs are left to solve on their own. With that in mind, me and my mother set out to establish a Jewelry brand named Atellier Organic.

Our goal was simple, build a strong reputable brand with a purpose-led strategy to not only source and produce our products in an eco-friendly and sustainable fashion but to also help other women entrepreneurs in our city obtain the same. While financial freedom for our family is naturally one of our primary objectives, we feel strongly in a community first approach that will both reduce inequality and will help bring about collective success. The journey for an entrepreneur in a developing country is not always the same as one living in a developed country.

Protect Biodiversity and Ecosystem
The brand is environmentally responsible by avoiding the use of gas torches, chemicals and waxes that affect the environment and health.



For starters, seldom do you hear of a woman starting a business for the sole reasons of passion. Most are born out of economic need and often as a primary source of income for a family. Further, it is rare that you find any government aid programs or support infrastructure to help you along your journey. In fact more often than not, the governments themselves introduce obstacles or barriers that act to suppress the entrepreneurial spirit. To the point that here in Mexico, there is a common view that it can be at times more dangerous to be in business than it is to be a criminal. Perhaps an exaggeration but not to be taken out of context.

Despite this struggle, coupled with the negative consequences of the pandemic, finding the right path to being a successful entrepreneur has forced me to think outside of the box and look beyond borders. Beyond this figurative wall, there are people who are willing to support the small businesses, mentor and coach them and it doesn't matter if you are an established business or one that is just starting out of your home dining room like me, there are those that believe in the potential social impact of what we're doing and it's up to me to pass on that same sense of purpose to the businesses in my community

Since the pandemic started in March 2020, I have experienced how large companies, recognized business people and international NGOs have focused on supporting entrepreneurs in developing countries, understanding their plight, and how their efforts could have a multiplier effect on the lives of the people, their families and their communities. And they're willing to give the same support to me that I now pass on to my community. For all small businesses in developing countries, I can see a light at the end of the tunnel, one that defines the new evolution of entrepreneurship in the face of social inequality


















### The Importance of Female Entrepreneurship

These days as I walk into my house my life looks a little like this: to my right I have my law firm Attorney in Heels  $^{\text{\tiny{M}}}$  with my desk covered in client files, to my left I have my four-year-old requesting some kind of snack, and toward the back of the house is my ten-year-old on a zoom class with her teacher and classmates telling us all to keep it down.

And as hard as it is for me to deal with the daily clash of my personal and professional life, thank you COVID 19, the truth is if it weren't for me having started my own law firm in 2018, I would have had it much harder. For one, I can theoretically run my law firm how I please, and if that means leaving certain work to be performed in middle of the night, then that's executive decision I can make as the Managing Attorney/ CEO/ Boss Babe, but more than anything I am following my dream.

Female entrepreneurship has been pivotal for women who face a need to balance parenting duties with the need to help create income to sustain their families, which if we're honest is almost all of us. Also, with the COVID 19 pandemic, four times as many women as men dropped out of the labor force in September of 2021, roughly 865,000 women compared with 216,000 men, so for many women the answer to recovering their lost income meant venturing into entrepreneurship.

However, this is not a new trend. In the last several years women have been starting businesses in droves. In 2017 women started a net total of 1.821 new businesses every day. According to the National Association of Women Business Owners, there are a total of 12.3 million women-owned businesses in the US. So why do I bring all these statistics up? Because what all of this tells us is that more and more women have been taking on their dreams and venturing into entrepreneurship either out of passion or necessity, but either way it is creating waves of change for us as more and more women will own and run the business world.



These waves of change are positive not only for women, but for the world overall. Statistics show that womenrun businesses often outperform those run by men. According to Forbes, private tech companies led by women achieve 35% higher return on investment. 

# THE POW(H)ER OF OUR IMAGINATION by Cheryl Quintana Leader

As an award-winning writer, director and producer, I've been among the fortunate to navigate the circuitous paths of how our society, and world at large, was created by the mere stroke of a pen and the storytelling imaginings of but a few select males of no color. Thus far, this country's beginnings were held hostage primarily by the perpetuation of archaic european ideals, imaginings and language.

This concrete foundation was then sufficiently dominated over with hate, fear and violence among the masses of all our conquered ones. Destructive domestication and submissive conditioning was carried out with the use of three simple pronouns -- he, his, him. And, by only two exalted gendered deitized words - father and son.

The first in this majority of our conquered ones were our mothers. She, her, hers was instantly cast aside, erased and obliterated within the imaginations among all of Mother Earth's beings. We the people – 52% of her daughters, birthing all beings, were imagined only as wicked temptress, witch/bruja insignificant, inferior, invisible or less than. We girls, young women, women and females were never to be fully elevated, honored, valued, respected, nor included as powerful forces unto her own. Despite being "more than equal" in the world, She was never again to be among any deities cherished thereafter in any storytelling or realms of "professed" knowing. Truth. In Her being.

Having been raised one of four daughters to a mother who never revealed her real name to us, nor telling us she had seven brothers and sisters as a third generation American growing up in Van Horn, Texas to signs that shouted "no negroes, no dogs, no Mexicans, no Jews," my mother Maria de la Luz wanted more for her children. So, soon after her own mother, Petra died painfully from lupus, she escaped the trappings of physical, emotional and sexual abuse from her father's side of the family to the deserts of Arizona.

As a young girl of ten, I remembered questioning outright where were all the powerful women in our stories of power? In our halls of truth and justice? Where were all our goddesses whom had originally permeated every continent with her innate abilities of healing, protection, nurturing, caring and love? Wasn't she the one providing sustenance for life from her very own body? Where was her deserved idolatry within all cultures? Was her societal majesty always elevated and upheld? What became of she, her, hers, mother, sister, daughter as integral powers? When had the story been changed and the disappearance, exclusion and dismantling of the goddess enacted?

Having a passion for the universe of our temples...our bodies, my teenage years were spent in becoming a heart or an eye surgeon as a Medical Explorer and later as a bio-med major at UCLA. As an avid athlete, I also excelled in gymnastics as most inspirational and then MVP my remaining three years. A compassionate combatant on behalf of women's rights, I became a journalist on our school newspaper due to articles rarely by-lined by or about women, the first mascot of our Spartan cheer squad, and selected to give my class's graduation speech. Courageously with my pen in one hand and a sword in the other. Writing memorable parting words in the image of our spirited Artemis goddess.

Despite my best efforts, my collegiate path instead led me toward a Bachelor of Arts in English. Writing found me once again, as did my added specialization with the new major on campus... "Women's Studies!" Upon being the first Latina on the Bruin gymnastics team, yes indeed walk-on dreams do come true!, I would experience many firsts. Not only as the first in my family to graduate both high school and college, but I would revel in first plane flights (to Penn State, LSU, Utah, Arizona, Oregon), initiated as a Greek sorority (Chi Omega) sister, and the first Latina on campus to host "A Woman's World", my own radio show on KLA where I was able to share diverse women's stories through voice.

Thereafter, and upon being selected a Chancellor's Marshall at graduation for my service to the University, I was advised that my writing talents would be best served in public relations and later among film and television script development which led me down the corridors of entertainment companies, studios, and agencies which rarely cast or crewed Latinas. There I was in the high-rise offices of industry icons, among the elite at celebrity award shows, or backstage on studio productions. Suddenly realizing these were the towers in which stories were told to elevate the world's talent "mortal gods/goddesses" – some with truth, yet most of the time with half truths, no truths or for the most part with raging embellishments. White lies? Well, we were the writers. We were the storytellers. Myth-makers. Fiction or not, we assisted in commanding fates. I felt the dark, dirty, dankness of my pen's power. Ever observing. Always imagining. So much so, that at one of my jobs in tv development where it was my job to share ideas or find projects for television MOWs (back in the day referred to Movie-of-the-Week) from Kirkus Reviews/Publisher's Weeklys (listing galleys of pre-published books for stories to be bought for possible movie/tv rights). Boldly, I even pitched my own script idea about a U.S. President character who happened to be Latina; and a book about a woman Vice President by an author whom was barely known at the time but would later become a renowned best-selling author - Mary Higgins Clark. To which my boss, a prim woman recently on the scene from Britain with her curated English accent, expressed very definitively, "We certainly can't make this story because there aren't any Latina Presidents or women Vice Presidents in America." Long pause. Polite stare. And, then another 'third trimester' pregnant pause. To which I finally returned an obvious reply, "You do know these projects are not documentaries, right?"

Projections are that by 2060, Latinas will form nearly a third of the female population of the nation.

Affirming once more that the industry I had come to know and love was still harboring irrational and unwarranted decision-making skills, when it came to "green-lighting" projects which reflected the blend of all our "united" storytellers under "one" nation indivisible with liberty and justice for all. Wasn't that the tale architected, told and to be be lie ved? Que lastima.

Fortunately, I would be able to take more control over what was written and imaged, when I became the winner of the Hispanic Film Project out of Universal TV for first-time writers who would be awarded \$20K and the opportunity to direct a 35mm film about their Hispanic-American experience. I was one of two Latinas chosen in the ten year history of the program. And, with my fascination of goddesses, I immediately ran to the fifth floor of UCLA's University Research Library after being told of the competition's deadline being in three days. I grabbed the relatively thin book on the Goddesses and Gods of Mexico, and lo and behold I opened to the page of the Goddess of the Fourth Sun. Legend has it that another Goddess or God had to be chosen as next Sun. And, since the head decision-maker didn't want the other male candidates to be mad at him, he decided to choose one of the most beautiful Goddess candidates. Since the other Gods loved her so much too they would not harbor any hard feelings toward him. Thus, the Goddess of Water was chosen to lead the Aztecs as the Fourth Sun, and everyone was fine except the Black God of Night because he had greedily wanted to be both Day and Night. So, he set out to bother her and upset her position as best he might. Until after 300 years, he had had enough and he whispered in her ear, "You know you didn't get this job because you're qualified...you got this job because you're beautiful." Now mind you this was a book written in the early seventies about a civilization many thousands of years prior. Well, you can imagine the Goddess of Water/The Fourth Sun's indignant and hurt reaction to his comment. So upset was she, that her tears of rage began to fall uncontrollably. What happens when water begins to torrent beyond measure? Wait for it. Yes. Floods. Thus, it was written that the Goddess of the Fourth Sun created the floods with her tears that ended her reign on Earth. And, as written, the Aztecs explained how actual floods from Mother Nature had occurred which destroyed their



My film, TANTO TIEMPO, featuring my own mother Luz, was interwoven with the Goddess of the Fourth Sun to illustrate that her story of being beautiful enough to have children with but not beautiful enough to marry, to be proud to share her culture and her language with her own family or in the country she was a third generation citizen of was part of her ancestral myths. Her story, through my imagination, went on to win five national awards, and an induction into the Museum of Modern Art/NY's Xicano Retrospective Archives. As well, I became the first Latina to ever produce a one-hour special to celebrate Hispanic Heritage Month with two short films coupled together written by and about the Hispanic-American experience hosted by Edward James Olmos and sponsored by Kodak, AT&T and Very Special Arts to 85% of the U.S. Syndicated TV Market. I reveled in having been the only one to sell my project and succeed in my mission to ensure that my actresses/actors would receive pay and their SAG/AFTRA cards for their talent.



With the lack of employment in the industry for Latina/o programming thereafter, and, not surprisingly even today, I went on to start my own production company INDIVISION2000 Productions to create educational media in English/Spanish for the Latina/o community via casting/crewing diverse women in front of and behind the camera for over 20 years now – several decades before #MeToo and #TimesUp. Happiness for me was providing projects that educated diverse women from Dove's Campaign for Real Beauty's 16-wk on-line series focused on Financial Literacy, Negotiation, Public Speaking, Authentic Voice and Advocacy, Healthy Babies (PreNatal Healthcare), Healthy Homes (Asthma Triggers/Environmental Safety at Home), The Purepecha: Poorest of the Poor (about our migrant farm-working families in the Coachella which assisted in getting 52 homes built, aired for a year on TimeWarner and was cited by Michelle Obama/Oprah Winfrey), among many more.

And, while I was unable to become the heart or eye surgeon I had once imagined for myself, I now know that I am helping others to feel from their hearts and see with their eyes what is truly possible and can be fully imagined for ourselves and others if only we create it.

Upon the horizon, I'm excited to be launching our Latina super heroine sci-fi series wherein the future of DTLA 2025 is filled with diverse women in S.T.E.A.M. fields ridding us of Shadow Invaders destroying Mother Earth. As well, it is with great satisfaction that we will be producing our tenth Latinas in Hollywood: HerStories (Performances) in celebration of International Women's Day -- & Our Stories (Educational Conferences) in celebration of Hispanic Heritage Month via Girls Build L.A., L.A. Promise Fund and Google HOLA/YouTube. In the pow(H)er of our Latinas' imaginations, we inspire our Latina high school, college and recent grads about one another, our mothers and grandmothers and the pow(H)er of our stories. A collective journey of matrilineal magistra mythology of our own making. Pens proudly in hand, and our creative imaginations firmly rooted in reality...and beyond!

My name is Melissa Gabilondo. I come from Mexican parents with the dream of being great and offering a great contribution in this world! Being people of immense conviction, they had the courage to leave their foundations and go out into the unknown to embark on a path where the uncertainty of the abyss invaded their entrails. But the desire and determination to provide their children and family a better future was stronger than their inner fears.

These are my parents at the young age of 20 when they immigrated from Mexico to the United States for the first time. As the years passed, destiny returned us to Mexico, but their security and perseverance was so great that they decided to immigrate for the second time 13 years after the first time, but this time it was different! My parents, despite adversity, paved the way where no Latino had done it before! They learned the language, they earned the trust and esteem of the people with their work and commitment, they created a company and delivered results like no one had done before, they grew and became distinguished in two states of the country

I tell this story to give you a bit of background where my strength and determination come from, it is one of the great inheritances that my parents have left me and that I embraced strongly! Having a goal and achieving it is something that I am passionate about and motivates me to do new things that manifest themselves as challenges, but in reality each challenge is an opportunity.

Emigrating between Mexico and the United States on multiple occasions generated changes and with them transformations. I had to quickly adapt to the new culture and to the new society. With an empty and colorless deep feeling in my chest I would close my eyes, take a deep breath and with my soul in hand I armed myself with courage and put the best version of myself before everyone.

The change of countries and cultures is something shocking at any age but for me it manifested itself when I was a teenager. The adolescent stage is difficult by itself but when a change of culture is added it becomes even more complicated. It became more difficult to identify what my true identity was, I didn't know if I was from here or there or if the right thing to do was to be true to my essence or to be who other people wanted me to be to feel like I fit in somewhere!

This is where my path of gratitude begins, even though I realized it years later!

Leaving my friends and family behind, I couldn't help but feel envy and jealous that they could continue with their lives without undergoing any change. Without having the emotional and sentimental distortion of being in another country with unknown people, having to learn their language, their culture, and customs and having to make new friends.
