

WELCOME TO HANK HARMON PUBLIC RANGE

RANGE RULES

ALWAYS Keep the gun pointed in a safe direction
ALWAYS Keep your finger off the trigger until ready to shoot
ALWAYS Keep the gun unloaded until ready to use

Safety:

- **THIS RANGE IS NOT SUPERVISED.** YOU are responsible for your safety and the safety of other range users.
- Use of or being under the influence of alcohol or drugs at the range is prohibited. (CBJ Resolution 2851)
- **Possession of a firearm when impaired by alcohol or drugs is illegal AS 11.61.210(a)(7)**
- Ear and eye protection are required for everyone at the range.
- Firearms must be unloaded, with the action open, and muzzle pointed in a safe direction when not being fired.
- When **anyone is downrange:**
 - All firearms must be unloaded with the action open.
 - No one may handle any firearm.
 - Everyone not downrange must stand behind the red line.
- Before firing, make sure no one is downrange and others on the firing line are ready to fire.
- Shoot straight downrange. Crossfire is not allowed.
- Cross draw holsters and shoulder holsters are not allowed for draw and fire practice.

- Youth 17 years old and younger must be supervised by an adult.
- Commercial metal targets must be used following the manufacturer's directions and placed no closer than 10 yards to the firing line.
- Commercial **exploding targets ONE pound or less** must be used following the manufacturer's and placed no closer than 50 yards.
- If you see anyone doing something unsafe or a violation of the rules above, use good judgment and diplomacy; DO NOT react aggressively. If you suspect alcohol or drugs are involved, call 911 and leave the area.

Courtesy:

- Pets are not allowed.
- The blast from large caliber firearms and those equipped with muzzle breaks can be extremely unpleasant to other shooters. Be aware of your muzzle blast.
- Black powder shooters try to take a shooting station downwind from other shooters if possible.
- **Keep the range clean! Pack it in; Pack it out.** Remove all litter including your targets and target holders. The following may not be used for targets: glass, furniture, electronic equipment, food items.
- Paintball guns are not allowed.
- Shooting at aerial targets is not allowed.
- **The range parking lot is only for people actively using the range**

Information:

- Range Hours of Operation: Sunrise to sunset as set by the schedule below and as determined by the overhead light by the bathroom in the parking lot. The light goes out at sunrise and turns on at sunset.
 - OPEN 7:00 am or when the light by bathroom is off (whichever is later)
 - CLOSED 9:00 pm or when the light by bathroom is on (whichever is earlier)
- The range is closed outside of the hours of operation:
- NO TRESPASSING. No one is allowed on range when closed without the permission of HHPRB

- The range may be reserved by contacting CBJ Parks and Recreation or HHPRB.
- Failure to comply with all posted range rules can result in loss of access to the range.
