

## Supplies to Purchase FOR ONLINE TUTORING

A regular laptop or desktop computer is needed. iPads or other tablets are not suitable for online tutoring. Google Chromebooks will also not work as some Zoom features (sharing control) won't function. A wired or wireless mouse for manipulating onscreen tiles and other items, or a touchscreen computer. (Optional if your student is a wiz at using the touchpad, but many aren't.)

A final guideline for the computer is: the newer, the better. I recommend using a computer that is less than 5 years old. The newer the computer, the more likely it will run well and manage the multi-tasking demanded of it during an online session.

A headset with earphones and a microphone – do not use earbuds or a microphone that is not attached to the headset.
