

Boarding Ladders Checklist:





Make sure your tail wagger can get back on your boat!!

Considerations to look into before investing in a dog ramp:

- -Durability, capacity & size of the ramp
- -Size & weight of your tail wagger
- —Ease of installation of the ramp
- —Ease of transport of the ramp
- —Slope & width of the ramp can your dog climb easily up onto your boat?
- -For smaller dogs do not buy a ramp that is too big
- —Does the ramp have a non-slip surface
- —What material is the ramp made out of for storage and care concerns most ramps are made of rubber, plastic, aluminium or a combination of these products
- —Consider alternative uses such as getting in and out of cars or climbing up on house furniture

Remember - your pup's weight is much denser in the water so take the extra weight into consideration!

Types of Ramps:

- -Folding ramps
- -Platform ramps
- —Beavertail folding ramps
- -Marine Dog boat ladder made with mesh material
