Self Managed vs. Management Company

- Self-managed can be time-consuming; requires more be done with volunteers.
- Past management company did not prove particularly good and was expensive.
- We save money by being self-managed.
- Both methods still require community involvement.

Budget/Finance

- The Board approved a substantial increase to keep pace with the increased costs.
- There are legislative initiatives from the Commonwealth of Virginia requiring HOAs be fully funded. Currently the CBF HOA does not have enough funds to replace or Tot Lot and maintain goals to reach full reserve status.
- A reserve study may need to be done to maintain compliance with Virginia Finance laws for HOAs.
- For 2025 trash is expected to cost \$300 per home (landfill costs will go up). This leaves \$220-\$245 for operating funds.
- Where do the dues go?
 - Trash and Recycling 58%
 - o Landscaping 23%
 - Common Area Reserve 10 % (%3,662 went into Reserve and \$2,975 spent on repairs).
 - Meeting Expenses 2%
 - Other Management Expenses 2%
 - O Website 1%

Tot Lot

- Other suggestions for the Tot Lot included adding covered/sealed trash cans, replace/repair/rebuild play structures, cutting back bushes, etc.
