

## TRANSITIONAL OPPORTUNITIES AVAILABLE

Applicants must call ahead to determine space availability and for a pre-screen interview. (502-797-7700) Applicants are processed by phone Mon - Fri 10 - 4 pm and Sat 10 - noon and must be available to meet by 4 pm for initial intake. Space is limited.

### **Basic Requirements**

- Desire and ability to participate in a structured program where accountability and respect are key
- ID (2 forms as required by employers)
- Be able to pass drug and alcohol screen (and stay drug and alcohol free during entire stay)
- Be willing & able to work a full - time / day time job in Bullitt County (Note: If receiving SSDI or SSI—contact us for possible part time exception)
- Must secure a job within two weeks of program entrance. (Non-employed participants are required to provide proof of FIVE job applications per day)

### RE-ESTABLISHMENT PROGRAM

- We accept and store 'goods' to help set up house-keeping for graduating guests
- As vehicles are donated and 'refurbished' they are made available at a very low cost to graduating 'good standing' guests
- Guests are expected to make themselves available to assist with pick-up / deliveries / repairs and organization of supplies
- Graduating guests in 'good-standing' are also eligible for our 'move-in' basket or gift card
- Guests will be expected to arrange the transportation and labor for delivery of items to their new 'abode' (typically use current guests to assist)

## EXPECTATIONS...

All Adult guests are expected to:

- Secure and hold a full time (40 hour) day-time job. We offer a comprehensive list of area employers and agencies. We also offer transportation for the first few weeks of employment
- Stay drug and alcohol free (random testing will confirm)
- Abide by ALL rules including: once you're accepted in the program, there are no 'nights out' prior to graduation.
- Participate in recovery programs as offered
- Learn to budget and save toward housing
- Plan to reach a level of self-sufficiency within 8-10 weeks
- Participate in our re-establishment program which offers household goods to help set up housekeeping and makes vehicles available as they are donated

## GUEST PROVISIONS / COSTS

- An evening meal
- Cots, bed linens, wash cloth & towel (all to be returned upon departure)
- Guests are responsible for their own lunches (Occasionally host sites / volunteers will provide a sack lunch &/or a lite breakfast)
- All guests will be issued a YMCA "Shower card" which entitles you to a shower from 1— 4pm.
- Outreach Thrift Store clothing voucher for up to 3 outfits.

### AFTER First Pay is received:

- \$50 / person "refundable" deposit
- \$35 / per person weekly fee (\$5 per day), payable on Sundays for the upcoming week
- Guests will secure their own transportation to/from work from a Shepherdsville central location
- Guests will be responsible for their own laundry costs
- 'Returning' guests will incur a daily fee of \$10 per person

Returning guests must re-qualify according to our stipulations.
