March Yarn Time — Cactus Pincushion

Here's a plant for your sewing room that won't need watering, plus it's a handy place to stick your pins! It uses small amounts of yarn that you may already have in your stash, all you need to do is take a trip to the garden center for a pot.

SUPPLIES:

Small amounts of brown and green medium weight (acrylic or cotton) yarn, a few yards of pink yarn

Size H/8 crochet hook

Poly fiber fill

3-1/2 - 4" clay flower pot

Optional: craft glue to secure the soil in the pot
Small pebbles to weigh down the bottom
