Open Sews:

We have three types of Open Sews. The first are just open sews and you can come in all day from 10am to 5pm and work on whatever you want. All of these are listed on the calendar!

The second type are **Kathy's Korners**. Most of the time Kathy's Korners are full so if you would like to join on a Weds please call the store on Tuesday and check with Kathy if there is room!

August Yarn Time — Christmas Trees and Snowmen

Christmas will be late this year — since we were celebrating America's 250th Anniversary last month, we'll be having Christmas in August instead. We'll be crocheting a Christmas tree and knitting a snowman. The snowman is made with two needles, no fiddling with double pointed needles, and he will use up some of your leftover yarn. And you can decorate the tree with leftover beads too.

SUPPLIES:

Christmas Tree —

1 skein medium weight yarn in green, or your favorite Christmas Tree color

Crochet hook size 8/H

Handful of rice or dried beans in a sandwich bag, to weigh down the bottom of the tree

Polyester stuffing

Yarn needle

Optional: 8-10 mm beads for tree ornaments

Snowman —

Small amount of white yarn, about 1 oz.

Small amounts of yarn for the hat and scarf

1-2 yards of black yarn for the 'coal' eyes and buttons

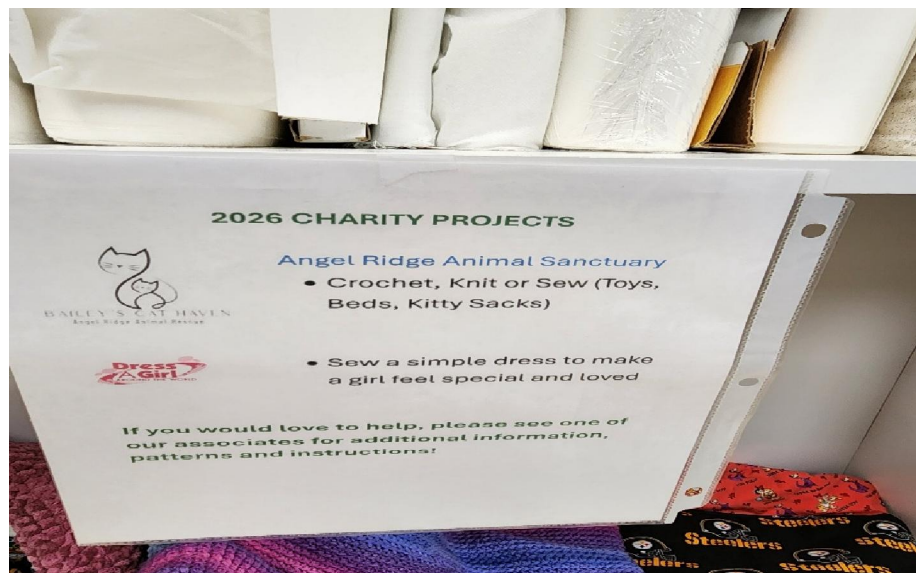
Knitting needles size 6

Yarn needle

Optional: weigh down his bottom with 1-2 tablespoons of rice or dried beans wrapped in plastic wrap
