July Yarn Time — Patriotic Pot Holders

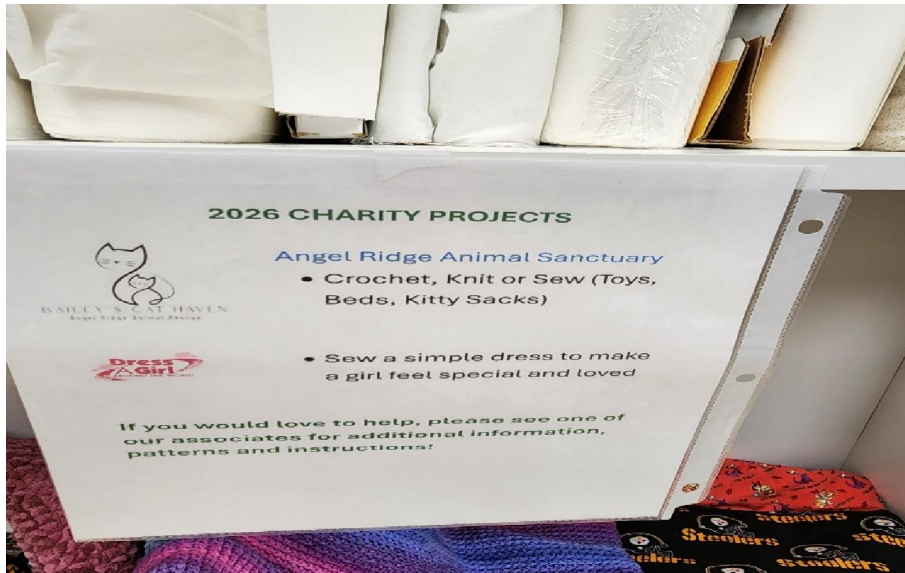

Supplies:

1 skein of Sugar and Cream cotton yarn in each color — red, white and blue (I am trying to get the yarn in so check in before the class to see if it comes in!). You can do all three pot holders with these three skeins Crochet hook size 8/H Yarn needle for weaving in ends
