#### **November Yarn Time - Granny Square Crochet Bed Socks**

Granny Squares are everywhere and now they're on your feet! The pair in the photo were made with a self-striping yarn but you can also crochet them with color changes on every round for a more traditional look. They can be made in size Small (5/6), Medium (7-8) and Large (9-10).

#### SUPPLIES:

1 skein self-striping medium weight (#4) yarn, or small amounts of medium weight yarn in different colors.

Crochet hook size H/8 Yarn needle
