JUST FACTS

Do You Know? "Each year, Americans observe National Hispanic Heritage Month from September 15 to October 15, by celebrating the histories, cultures, and contributions of American citizens whose ancestors came from Spain, Mexico, the Caribbean and Central and South America. The observation started in 1968 as Hispanic Heritage Week under President Lyndon Johnson and was expanded by President Ronald Reagan in 1988 to cover a 30-day period starting on September 15 and ending on October 15.

It was enacted into law on August 17, 1988, on the approval of Public Law 100-402. The day of September 15 is significant because it is the anniversary of independence for Latin American countries Costa Rica, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, and Nicaragua. In addition, Mexico and Chile celebrate their independence days on September 16 and September18, respectively. Also, Columbus Day or Día de la Raza, which is October 12, falls within this 30-day period (www.census.gov/newsroom/stories)."

WHAT'S COOKING?

¹⁹ "There was a rich man who was dressed in purple and fine linen and lived in luxury every day. ²⁰ At his gate was laid a beggar named Lazarus, covered with sores ²¹ and longing to eat what fell from the rich man's table. Even the dogs came and licked his sores.

²² "The time came when the beggar died, and the angels carried him to Abraham's side. The rich man also died and was buried. ²³ In Hades, where he was in torment, he looked up and saw Abraham far away, with Lazarus by his side. ²⁴ So he called to him, 'Father Abraham, have pity on me and send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue, because I am in agony in this fire.'

²⁵ "But Abraham replied, 'Son, remember that in your lifetime you received your good things, while Lazarus received bad things, but now he is comforted here, and you are in agony. ²⁶ And besides all this, between us and you a great chasm has been set in place, so that those who want to go from here to you cannot, nor can anyone cross over from there to us.'

²⁷ "He answered, 'Then I beg you, father, send Lazarus to my family, ²⁸ for I have five brothers. Let him warn them, so that they will not also come to this place of torment.'

²⁹ "Abraham replied, 'They have Moses and the Prophets; let them listen to them.'

³⁰ "'No, father Abraham,' he said, 'but if someone from the dead goes to them, they will repent.'

³¹ "He said to him, 'If they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not be convinced even if someone rises from the dead (Luke 16:19-31)."



Whole Wheat Pasta Salad {Yield: 10-12 servings}

Ingredients:

8 oz. box Whole Wheat Rotini (spiral shaped pasta) 1 bell pepper, diced 1 cucumber, seeded, and diced 1⁄2 cup chopped green onions 1⁄2 cup diced tomatoes 1⁄2 cup chopped celery 2 Tbsp. parsley, minced 1 tsp black pepper 3⁄4 cup lite shredded cheddar cheese

Dressing:

(COMBINE ALL) 1/3 cup fat free yogurt, plain 1/3 cup fat free honey Dijon dressing 1/3 cup fat free Caesar dressing 1 Tbsp. dill, minced

Instructions:

- 1. Boil pasta according to directions on box.
- 2. Drain, rinse and chill pasta.
- 3. Mix with other ingredients and dressing and serve.


