FACTS

Do You Know? "Suicide is death caused by injuring oneself with the intent to die. A suicide attempt is when someone harms themselves with any intent to end their life, but they do not die because of their actions. Many factors can increase the risk for suicide or protect against it.

- Suicide is a leading cause of death in the United States. It was responsible for nearly 46,000 deaths in 2020.
- In 2020, an estimated 12.2 million adults seriously thought about suicide, 3.2 million made a plan, and 1.2 million attempted suicide.
- Suicide rates in 2020 were 30% higher than in 2000.

Suicide is connected to other forms of injury and violence. For example, people who have experienced violence, including child abuse, bullying, or sexual violence have a higher suicide risk. Being connected to family and community support and having easy access to health care can decrease suicidal thoughts and behaviors (https://www.cdc.gov/suicide/facts/index.html)."

²⁵ Large crowds were traveling with Jesus and turning to them he said: ²⁶ "If anyone comes to me and does not hate father and mother, wife and children, brothers, and sisters—yes, even their own life—such a person cannot be my disciple. ²⁷ And whoever does not carry their cross and follow me cannot be my disciple.

²⁸ "Suppose one of you wants to build a tower. Won't you first sit down and estimate the cost to see if you have enough money to complete it? ²⁹ For if you lay the foundation and are not able to finish it, everyone who sees it will ridicule you, ³⁰ saying, 'This person began to build and wasn't able to finish.'

31 "Or suppose a king is about to go to war against another king. Won't he first sit down and consider whether he is able with ten thousand men to oppose the one coming against him with twenty thousand 32 If he is not able, he will send a delegation while the other is still a long way off and will ask for terms of peace. 33 In the same way, those of you who do not give up everything you have cannot be my disciples (Luke 14:25-33)."

WHAT'S COOKING?



Meatloaf Surprise

{Yield: 6 servings, serving size 3/4 cup}

Ingredients:

1 lb. ground beef, 95% lean

1 medium bell pepper, rinsed, chopped (~2 cups)

1 medium onion, finely chopped (~1 cup)

3/4 cup oats (quick or old-fashioned)

8 oz. fresh mushrooms, chopped (~2 cups)

12 oz. fresh spinach, rinsed, chopped (~2 cups)

1 egg

1/4 tsp black pepper

1/4 tsp dry thyme

1/4 tsp dry rosemary

1 tsp olive oil

Instructions:

- 1. Heat oven to 350F. Spray bread/loaf pan with PAM or nonstick spray.
- 2. In a skillet, heat the oil over medium heat. Add the onion and stir frequently for about 2 minutes.
- 3. Add the bell pepper and mushrooms, cook another 2 minutes. Add spinach and cover for 1 minute until wilted.
- 4. Remove from heat and set aside. In a bowl, combine remaining ingredients.
- 5. Add cooked vegetables to the beef mixture; if it appears too dry, add more oats.
- 6. Transfer to bread pan and form into a loaf. Bake for an hour or until juices run clear and meat is no longer pink inside (may need to spoon off juices halfway through cooking).
