### FACTS

**Do You Know?** "Suicide is death caused by injuring oneself with the intent to die. A suicide attempt is when someone harms themselves with any intent to end their life, but they do not die because of their actions. Many factors can increase the risk for suicide or protect against it.

- Suicide is a leading cause of death in the United States. It was responsible for nearly 46,000 deaths in 2020.
- In 2020, an estimated 12.2 million adults seriously thought about suicide, 3.2 million made a plan, and 1.2 million attempted suicide.
- Suicide rates in 2020 were 30% higher than in 2000.

Suicide is connected to other forms of injury and violence. For example, people who have experienced violence, including child abuse, bullying, or sexual violence have a higher suicide risk. Being connected to family and community support and having easy access to health care can decrease suicidal thoughts and behaviors (https://www.cdc.gov/suicide/facts/index.html)."

### WHAT'S COOKING?

<sup>1</sup> Now the tax collectors and sinners were all gathering around to hear Jesus. <sup>2</sup> But the Pharisees and the teachers of the law muttered, "This man welcomes sinners and eats with them."

<sup>3</sup> Then Jesus told them this parable: <sup>4</sup> "Suppose one of you has a hundred sheep and loses one of them. Doesn't he leave the ninety-nine in the open country and go after the lost sheep until he finds it? <sup>5</sup> And when he finds it, he joyfully puts it on his shoulders <sup>6</sup> and goes home. Then he calls his friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost sheep.' 7 I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in heaven over one sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons who do not need to repent.

<sup>8</sup> "Or suppose a woman has ten silver coins and loses one. Doesn't she light a lamp, sweep the house and search carefully until she finds it? <sup>9</sup> And when she finds it, she calls her friends and neighbors together and says, 'Rejoice with me; I have found my lost coin.' <sup>10</sup> In the same way, I tell you, there is rejoicing in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner who repents (Luke 15:1-10)."



### **Meatloaf Surprise**

{Yield: 6 servings, serving size <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> cup} *Ingredients:* 1 lb. ground beef, 95% lean 1 medium bell pepper, rinsed, chopped (~2 cups) 1 medium onion, finely chopped (~1 cup) 3/4 cup oats (quick or old-fashioned) 8 oz. fresh mushrooms, chopped (~2 cups) 12 oz. fresh spinach, rinsed, chopped (~2 cups) 1 egg

<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> tsp black pepper
<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> tsp dry thyme
<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> tsp dry rosemary
1 tsp olive oil

### Instructions:

- 1. Heat oven to 350F. Spray bread/loaf pan with PAM or nonstick spray.
- 2. In a skillet, heat the oil over medium heat. Add the onion and stir frequently for about 2 minutes.
- 3. Add the bell pepper and mushrooms, cook another 2 minutes. Add spinach and cover for 1 minute until wilted.
- 4. Remove from heat and set aside. In a bowl, combine remaining ingredients.
- 5. Add cooked vegetables to the beef mixture; if it appears too dry, add more oats.
- 6. Transfer to bread pan and form into a loaf. Bake for an hour or until juices run clear and meat is no longer pink inside (may need to spoon off juices halfway through cooking).
