JUST FACTS

Do You Know? "On average, nearly 20 people per minute are physically abused by an intimate partner in the United States. During one year, this equates to more than 10 million women and men.

- On a typical day, there are more than 20,000 phone calls placed to domestic violence hotlines nationwide.
- Domestic victimization is correlated with a higher rate of depression and suicidal behavior.

Victims of intimate partner violence lose a total of 8.0 million days of paid work each year (https://ncadv.org/STATISTICS)."

Whole Wheat Pasta Salad {Yield: 10-12 servings}

Ingredients:

8 oz. box Whole Wheat Rotini (Spiral-shaped pasta) 1 bell pepper, diced 1 cucumber, seeded, and diced 1⁄2 cup chopped green onions 1⁄2 cup diced tomatoes 1⁄2 cup chopped celery 2 Tbsp. parsley, minced 1 tsp black pepper 3⁄4 cup lite shredded cheddar cheese

Dressing:

(COMBINE ALL) 1/3 cup fat free yogurt, plain 1/3 cup fat free honey Dijon dressing 1/3 cup fat free Caesar dressing 1 Tbsp. dill, minced

Instructions:

- 1. Boil pasta according to directions on box.
- 2. Drain, rinse and chill pasta.
- 3. Mix with other ingredients and dressing and serve.
