CHATHAM MOMS FOR CHANGE ENDORSES MIKIE SHERRILL FOR CONGRESS

Fairfield, NJ -- Following a successful Facebook Live event on Wednesday, April 18, Chatham Moms for Change endorsed Democratic candidate Mikie Sherrill in her bid to represent the 11th District of New Jersey in Congress.
