

Stuttgart Country Club Pool Rules

Pool Sign-In: All Country Club members need to sign in at the desk located at the front gate before entering the pool area.

Guests: A guest is anyone other than the immediate family of a club member.

Guest Registry: Members must sign in their guest's name and residence address in the Guest Registry which will be located in the sign-in book at the front gate. Any misuse of guest privileges will result in a \$10.00 member fine.

Guest Fees:

A. An out-of-town guest is someone living beyond a 30 air-mile radius of the Country Club. There is no fee for out-of-town guests and no limit on the number of visits.

B. An in-town guest is someone living within a 30 air-mile radius of the Country Club. Members will be billed at \$10.00 per guest and visits will be limited to one visit per month. Members may bring a particular guest once a month. However, another member may bring the same guest once a month as well. Any in town guest is limited to 5 visits per month. (Visitation limit will exclude invitations to pool parties.)

Pool Parties: Those wishing to have a pool party will be billed \$150.00. The Club will pay the lifeguards and guests will be limited to 16 swimmers. Pool parties are booked through the pool chairman.

Baby Sitters: Baby sitters may be considered an exception to the guest rule by the following guidelines:

A. The member submits a letter to the pool chairman naming the sitter.

B. Sitters may bring children of Club members only.

C. Sitter should be registered with the Club prior to swimming session or ASAP.

D. Sitters may accompany parents to the pool as long as they are performing their Duties as baby sitter.

E. The charge for the sitter will be \$10.00 per day or the member may purchase a Sitter Season Pass for \$50.00 from the office. One sitter per pass only.

Children: Children under the age of 10 years old must be accompanied by an adult at all times. Also, children of any age who are unable to swim the length of the pool must be accompanied by an adult. Any child 10 years or older who will be dropped off at the pool without an adult must have an emergency card with phone numbers on file with the lifeguards. The card must be on file before a child may be left at the pool. The baby pool is available for children 3 feet and under. Adults or children over 3 feet may enter the baby pool only when supervising a smaller child. No jumping or climbing over the fence.

Horseplay: Running inside the fence area is not allowed. Games such as baseball, etc. should be played in the 4-5 floor area of the pool. Smaller children have the right-of-way at the shallow end of the pool. Dunking and pushing others in the pool is not allowed. Back flips from the side of the pool are not allowed. Diving into the shallow end of the pool is not allowed.

Golf Carts/Clubs: Golf carts are not allowed in the area between the pool house and the pool fence. Golf carts should be parked beside the pool house. Children should not swing golf clubs in or around the pool area.

Lifeguard Stand: No one is allowed on the lifeguard stand other than the lifeguard on duty.

Diving Board: Only one person at a time on the diving board. Diver must be clear of the diving area before the next diver can go. Swimming across the diving area is not allowed while people are diving.

Disorderly Conduct: Lifeguards will document and discuss any habitual, unruly conduct with parents.

Forbidden Objects: Metal toys, tennis balls, golf balls, tees and glass objects are not allowed inside the pool area.

Lost and Found: Lost and found articles are located on a table in the women's dressing room. Any articles left over two weeks will be given to the Salvation Army.

Lifeguard Visits: Lifeguards are not allowed to visit or to have visitors while on duty.

Clubhouse Visits: Cover-ups and shoes must be worn if you go into the Clubhouse.

Vending Machines: Vending machines are located between the men's and women's dressing rooms.

Pool Hours: Lifeguard on duty from 11:00 am – 6:00 pm, Monday thru Saturday, Sunday 1:00 pm - 5:00 pm.

Opening/Closing Date: Opening Day for the pool will Memorial Day weekend.
Closing Day will be Labor Day.

Please discuss all rules with your children and guests. Please give your support and respect to the lifeguards. We appreciate all your support in making this a successful "swimming" summer.
