Camp Description and Projected Outcomes

Fostering The Arts Spirit of Excellence Summer Camp will be a six-week youth Performing Arts Camp for ages 4-17. This program will allow young people a positive alternative of expression, along with the development of teamwork skills, self-motivational tools, integrity, work ethics, and good character. This program will allow insight into their development of thinking and cognitive abilities, while gaining symbolic input through the exploration of different media. This six-week process of creating utilizing the Arts could aid parents and medical professionals in evaluating potential ADHD issues; focus, motor control, memory, managing emotions, organization, sequencing and decision-making. Engaging in the Arts has also shown to improve emotional well-being, help develop problem-solving skills, along with enhancing social interaction skills and boundaries.
