RETURN BALLOT BY JUNE 10TH

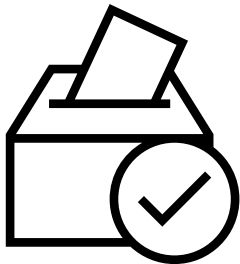


Vote-by-mail ballots will be mailed out on September 25th to all voters on the permanent vote-by-mail list.

Return your complete ballot at any drop box in Middlesex County before 8 p.m. on June 10th or place it in the mail. No postage necessary.

EARLY IN-PERSON VOTING

JUNE 6TH TO JUNE 8TH

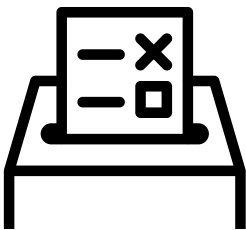


Early in-person voting is available from June 6th through June 8th. You can vote at any of the 10 early voting locations throughout Middlesex County.

Locations will be open June 6th and June 7th from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. and June 8th from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.

VOTE ON ELECTION DAY

JUNE 10TH, 2025



The last chance to vote is in person at your polling place. Polls will be open from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Election Day. Accommodations will be made for voters with disabilities.
