VOTE BY MAIL

RETURN BALLOT BY NOVEMBER 7TH

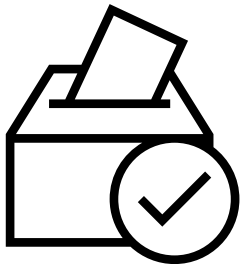


Vote-by-mail ballots will be mailed out on September 25th to all voters on the permanent vote-by-mail list.

Return your complete ballot at any drop box in Middlesex County before 8 p.m. on November 7th or place it in the mail. No postage necessary.

EARLY IN-PERSON VOTING

OCTOBER 28TH - NOVEMBER 5TH

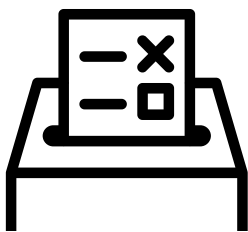


Early in-person voting is available from October 28th through November 5th. You can vote at any of the 10 early voting locations throughout Middlesex County.

Locations will be open October 28th through November 4th from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. and November 5th from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.

VOTE ON ELECTION DAY

NOVEMBER 7TH



The last chance to vote is in person at your polling place. Polls will be open from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Election Day. Accommodations will be made for voters with disabilities.
