These foundational techniques now inform his newest artistic direction: a series of work focused exploration of the Tetragrammaton (יהוה), the ancient four-letter representation of God's personal name. By carrying his established style into this deeper thematic territory, Ron creates a seamless bridge between abstract expression and contemplation.

Rooted in a longtime interest in history, linguistics, and culture, his work resonates with audiences who appreciate both beauty and meaning. Every piece is an invitation to reflect on the relevance of the Divine Name and its message of hope, identity, and purpose.

Ron's studio practice incorporates meditative techniques, repetitive forms, and meticulous craftsmanship. Centered on precision and mindfulness, his artistic process welcomes collaboration—particularly with neurodivergent individuals whose unique strengths align with the focused and intentional nature of his work.
