Reminders:

- 1. Please bring a family photo for us to put up in classroom, a picture of home pets are welcome, they are also family $\ref{eq:continuous}$
- 2. Two all about me projects will be going home for family involvement, please return them all by Monday September 16th
- 3. Be sure your child has all diapers as needed and if wearing pull-ups, please bring pull-ups with velcro sides (Huggies brand are great), there are 12 children we need to help during the potty training process. Our goal is to have all of our kids potty trained or actively going through the potty training process by the beginning of 2025. Please see Ms. Rachael if you need some good advice about the potty training process.
- 4. Please send a sleeping bag and a small pillow for rest time. Every child is required to rest for at least 30 minutes. If they do not sleep we will offer them a quiet activity for the rest of our resttime.
- 5. Please send in a lunch box with a **healthy** lunch for your child daily. We do not heat or refrigerate food so if something needs to be served hot please preheat it at home and send it in a thermos. If it needs to be kept cold please put an icepack in your child's lunch box.
- 6. Send a refillable water bottle with your child daily. Please make sure it has fresh water in it when they come to school.
- 7. Our classes will communicate through the procare app. Their daily activities will not be logged by individual events rather they will be summarized at the end of their educational portion of their day. If you need to communicate with your child's teacher please use the procare app, email them victoria.haynes@fclcwi.com, edie.rognerud@fclcwi.com, or olivia.wellman@fclcwi.com, or call the office @ 262-632-7311. They will respond when they are able or by the next school day they are working.
- 8. Please send in extra clothes for your child to be stored in their cubby. Please remember to send in weather appropriate clothing including socks and underwear.

- 9. Please send your child with a child size backpack for them to carry their belongings to class. They will be expected to carry their things to the lower level each day so please do not make them so heavy they can't carry them.
- 10. Each month every child should send in a healthy 2 part snack for 16 children. These should be sent in at the beginning of each month. We will let you know when we have a surplus of something as well as ideas of things to send in. Please choose from 2 different food groups. We love cut-up fresh fruit and veggies too:)
