



Find hidden historical gems! Wander through three centuries of time, while you shop, eat, and are entertained in Heathsville, the historical heart of Northumberland County.

Start your day with morning sustenance at **360 Grill** in Burgess or the **Lottsburg CaPé**.

Step Back in Time! In Heathsville, visit **Rice's Hotel/Hughlett's Tavern**, an historical landmark that dates to the 1700s.

See **Traditional Artisans** at Work! While at the Tavern, chat with Blacksmiths, Woodworkers, Quilters, Spinners, and Weavers.

Take Home a Memory! Shop for locally made handcrafts in the **Tavern Gift Shoppe**, which consigns the wares of over 100 artists and artisans.

Eat Lunch at the **Tavern CaPé**. Enjoy light luncheon fare made by the volunteers of the Tavern Culinary Guild. The Tavern bakes all its own breads.

INSIDER TIPI Ask for the Almond Brioche—its signature bread.

INSIDER TIPI Visit the Tavern on the third Saturday, April through October, for the Heathsville Farmers Market.

Take a Walk through History! Pick up a walking map of **Historic Heathsville**. Get the back-story on the **Old Northumberland Courthouse**, **Old Jail**, and local plantation homes as you wander.

Get Back to the Land! Tour the **Northern Neck Farm Museum** for a glimpse of historical and current farming equipment and practices.

Find Your Bliss at **Triple V Farms** for a relaxed afternoon of wine and cocktails! The "V" stands for vines, vodka, and vinegar!

Dinner time! Come by land or water to **Horn Harbor Restaurant** in Burgess. Or enjoy quiet wooded views from your table at **Unique Experience Eatery** in Heathsville.

Reedville is world-known for its Menhaden Fishing industry—a fish used in fertilizers, animal food and vitamins. **Explore its 150-year history** and the life of commercial fishermen.

Get Started with a quick breakfast at **Little River Market** or a sit-down experience at the **360 Grill**.

INSIDER TIPI Head to **Pride of Virginia SeaFood Products** before 9:00 a.m. to watch the fishing boats bring in fresh catch.

Tour the Reedville Fishermen's Museum. Thurs-Sat, 11-4. See exhibits on the life of the watermen, hands-on KidzKorners, historic vessels, model train villages, artwork, and more.

Take a walking tour of "Millionaires Row," beautiful Victorian homes built by wealthy Menhaden Factory owners and boat captains, along with smaller fishermen's cottages.

Lunch time in Reedville! Fresh crab cakes, shrimp salad, burgers, and more await you at **Cockrell's Creek SeaFood & Deli** with outdoor picnic tables on the Creek. Or head to **Fairport Marina's "Lead Bellies"** with fresh seafood and fish, a full bar, and a screened-in porch right off the dock.

Head back to the Reedville Fishermen's Museum Gift Shop for kid's books and games; artwork, hand-crafted items, woodwork and more by local artisans.

On the 2nd and 4th Friday (May-Oct.) board the **Elva C** for a tour of **Cockrell's Creek**.

Take a break at **Chitterchats Ice Cream Parlor** for ice cream and freshly made waffle cones, floats, shakes, and sundaes.

For great water views, head to **The Crazy Crab**. Fresh fish, seafood, plus options for the landlubber!

Have drinks and dinner at the **Reedville Market** in a glass enclosed porch for casual dining.
