With walking paths, boardwalks, and viewing platforms, this preserve is the home and resting area for an abundance of feeder fish, waterfowl, and wading birds, such as egrets, pelicans, cormorants, and the great blue heron.

#### AM: STEP BACK IN TIME!

In Heathsville, visit Rice's Hotel/Hughlett's Tavern, an historical landmark that dates to the 1700's. The Tavern is home to four artisan guilds, the Tavern Cafe', several artisan studios, and the Tavern Gift Shoppe. Walk around our grounds. The Tavern is the oldest structure in Heathsville. Open Thursday – Saturday, 10 am to 2 pm, the Tavern is located at 73 Monument Place, right behind the Old Courthouse in Heathsville, VA 22473. (804) 580-3377. www.rhhtfoundationinc. org. See Traditional Artisans at Work! While at the Tavern, chat with Blacksmiths, Woodworkers, Quilters, and Spinners & Weavers as they work. Follow the smoke to the Blacksmiths in the Forge behind the Tavern (Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday, 10 am – 12 noon, reliably, unless it's too hot or too cold!). The Quilters have a studio on the first floor in the Tavern, and the Spinners & Weavers' studio is upstairs. The Guilds offer classes, too.

**INSIDER TIP!** Visit on the third Saturday, April thru October, for the **Heathsville Farmers Market**, 9 am – 1 pm, held outside on the Tavern Green. All the guilds are on-site that day, demonstrating and selling their wares. Special on market day, the Tavern Cafe' makes glazed donuts hot out of the fryer. About 50 vendors at each market, with local produce, meat, baked goods, gourmet peanuts, fancy BBQ sauce, plants and flowers, and locally made handcrafts.

**Take Home a Memory!** Shop for locally made handcrafts in the **Tavern Gift Shoppe**, which consigns the wares of over 100 artists and artisans. Several artisans also have their studio on-site, including two jewelry makers, a weaver/spinner/tatter/knitter, a painter who takes furniture "roadkill" and gives it a whimsical new look, and sewer/woodburner who makes wine totes, earrings, decorative cook-spoons and more. Buy handcrafted pottery, baskets, wooden bowls, quilts, shawls, greeting cards, kitchen towels, and more. Each item is unique unto itself.

# LUNCH

Eat Lunch at the **Tavern Cafe'**! Enjoy light luncheon fare made by the volunteers of the **Tavern Culinary Guild**. This includes homemade soups, salads, quiche, sandwiches and featured specials, plus sweet treats. The menu changes weekly, depending on what the volunteers want to make!

INSIDER TIP! The Tavern bakes all their own breads. Ask for the Almond Brioche - it is their signature bread.

Early riser? Drop over to **Pride of Virginia Seafood Products** at 900 Main Street (804-453-6191) before 9am and watch the fishing boats come in with fresh catch, oysters, crabs, and other seafood. This is where several local restaurants pick up the fresh fish for the day.

Explore the **Reedville Fishermen's Museum** at 504 Main Street to discover the rich history and culture of the lower Chesapeake Bay and the waters surrounding Reedville. For days and hours, see www.rfmuseum.org or call 804-453-6529.

The **Reedville Fishermen's Museum**, Thur. – Sat. 11-4, is filled with exhibits, displays, a hands-on room called KidzKorners, a unique gift shop, the Walker House (oldest home in Reedville), a working boat shop, a model (train) shop, the Herman Krentz pilot house, historic vessels, beautiful gardens, and lots more. During the summer the Museum hosts outdoor concerts, and cruises on the Elva C – free but require reservations. This is a truly magical maritime museum!

Take a **walking tour of Reedville** and explore Main Street. See "Millionaires Row," beautiful Victorian homes built by wealthy Menhaden factory owners and boat captains, as well as smaller fishermen's cottages. Pick up a walking tour map at the Museum and head out for a short walk back in time.

Freshly caught crabs, and oysters, along with scallops, fresh shrimp salad, great burgers, and lots of terrific sides await you. You can stock up on food to go as well.
