COSTS & CHARGES

MEMBERSHIP

In order to allow Fylde Coast Soccer (FCS) to be sustainable and to provide teams with the required documentation, insurances, league entry, equipment, etc; membership incurs an initial signing on fee and a monthly fee.

Signing on

- Yearly membership joining fee is frozen at £40. This is paid once annually before the start of the new season.
- For a new member, this is paid at the point of joining then henceforth at the start of every new season on 1st July.

Monthly subs

Training only:

- £5 per session or
- Standard monthly subs at £25.
- This is due to be paid on or around the 1st of each month.

Training & league matches once in one of our teams:

- Monthly subs are £27.50.
- This is due to be paid on or around the 1st of each month.

GAMES NIGHT:

- An additional session, Games Night, will be on offer each week at a cost of £5 to non—FCS players & just £3 for players signed to FCS.
- This is due to be paid on the evening.



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FCS Sibling discount

Please note: FCS have a sibling discount policy where younger siblings' subs are half price on all our price plans.

Paying subs/fees

Where possible, the club operates a 'cashless' system and as such, all payments should be paid into the club bank account. We try to avoid no cash payments but can do for those who prefer to pay via cash. A committee member will issue with a receipt for any cash payments. The Standing Order Instructions at the end of this document contains the details required to set up a standing order either via online banking or by taking the details into the local branch of your bank.

The membership fee from each player contributes to the cost of paying for a player to join the appropriate football league and be affiliated with the FA each year.

The monthly subs contribute to, but are not limited to, venue hire, adult supervision, equipment purchase and replacement, pitch hire and insurance. These costs are not necessarily incurred to the same value by the club on a monthly basis. Therefore, the required yearly contribution for each player is split between the 12 months of the year – henceforth, subs must be paid each and every month, irrespective of whether the player attends training that week, for the duration of their time at the club.

Late payment will be chased up by the Club Committee. As a result of missed or late payments, a player's insurance will lapse and as a result they will be banned from training and matches until the policy can be renewed.

Training Kits

FCS offer a training kit package for our Reception/Year 1 Development Group at the cost of £25 (cost incurred by FCS) depending. These consist of:

- socks
- shorts
- t-shirt

We also offer our Nike performance rain jackets for all age groups with FCS logo & players initials on for

- £30



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Kits are not compulsory – children are able to train in any suitable sportswear. If a parent chooses to purchase a kit, this is ordered through the club and the cost is paid into the club bank account or to Chairman Mike McGarvey if paying via cash where he will issue a receipt. This kit becomes the property of the child and their parent. It is the parents' responsibility to provide suitable footwear and shin pads.

Match Day Kits

Once players enter Year 2 at school, they are old enough to be entered into the league and play matches each weekend of the season for an FCS team. Match kits are normally purchased via club fundraising or sponsorship. The match day kits remain the property of the club and if lost or damaged beyond reasonable wear and tear, parents will be expected to fund a replacement. Should a player leave the club, their match kit must be returned in full within 7 days of their final match or training session. Failure to do so will result in them becoming unable to sign for another club. All parents will be asked to sign and agree to these terms on receipt of a new match kit.

Tournaments

During the off-season, there are often tournaments organised around the region that teams from FCS may choose to enter. These tournaments usually have an entrance fee. These fees are not covered by the monthly payments from each player and the club would be unable to sustain itself if it was to fund these competitions. As a result, the cost of the entrance fee will be split between the players who are attending and playing. Parents may decline to pay the fee but their child will not be entered into the tournament. If a coach does not have enough entrants from his own team, he may approach, with the authorisation of the committee, players from an FCS team at the same or a younger age group.

The membership and monthly fees paid by parents cover the cost of entrance in the winter leagues only. Any summer or futsal leagues will be classified as a tournament and as such, will be subject to the guidelines above.

Payments:

- 1 x payment of £27.50 to be taken immediately. (£41.25 if there are 2 siblings)
- Monthly payment of £25 on the 1st of each month. (£37.50 if there are 2 siblings) Based on training per week.

POLITE NOTICE Please be reminded that players who have outstanding (or unpaid) fees are not insured against accident or injury and therefore will be turned away from training and/or matches until their account is clear. If you are ever unable to make a payment, it is imperative that you inform the club so that suitable arrangements can be made for your child. If a player enters 3 months of arrears their FCS membership will be terminated & any club kit will need to be returned immediately.
