left-handed guitarist to appear on national TV. He's appeared in the country's finest nightclubs, including N.Y. C's famous COPACABANA. . He also performed at Carnegie Hall.. He released a few albums in the seventies and eighties with his partner Colin Mc Rory under the name "RED HOOK" as well as recording a solo "New Age" album "FREE SPIRIT" in 1995.



**Feb. 11, 2023—Kalani Pieper.** Singer/Entertainer performing in local country clubs and fraternal organizations during the Winter season. Kalani is a favorite at our Elks lodge and plays a variety of music ranging from the 60's to the current hits. He is sure to please the crowd.




