

WHAT IS HOSPICE

HOSPICE CARE IS FOR PATIENTS WITH A LIFE-LIMITING ILLNESS AS
DETERMINED BY THEIR PHYSICIAN, AND MEETS THE MEDICARE
ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR THE HOSPICE DIAGNOSIS.
HOSPICE CARE IS NOT CURATIVE IN NATURE, BUT FOCUSES ON COMFORT
AND THE ENHANCEMENT OF QUALITY OF LIFE.

Mission Statement
