IMPERIAL CHRYSOBULL OF RECOGNITION

Concerning Tibet, Taiwan, and the People's Republic of
China

**Issued from the Desk of His Imperial Majesty,
Emperor Bryce L.S.P. Ivrea I, Basileus and
Autokrator of the Confederated Empire and all its
Sovereign Domains, Defender of the Faith, Defender
of the Imperial Constitution, Sovereign Grand
Master of the Knights of Napoleon, Commander of
the Legions, Captain of the 10th Tennessee
Regiment, Captain of the Molossian Navy, Lord of
Sealand, Lord of Glencoe, Protector of the
Sovereign Rights of Nations, and Supreme Guardian
of the Imperial Crown.**

By the Grace of Almighty God and by the Authority of
the Imperial Crown

Let all unto whom these Imperial Letters shall come
know that the Imperial Crown, exercising its sovereign
authority and mindful of the ancient traditions of justice,
honor, and the lawful rights of nations, does hereby
issue this Imperial Chrysobull, to be entered into the
perpetual registers of the Imperial Chancellery and

preserved among the fundamental acts of the
Confederated Empire.

Whereas the principles of national self-determination,
liberty, and the inherent dignity of all peoples are among
the highest ideals upheld by the Imperial Crown;

Whereas the Tibetan people have preserved throughout
the centuries their distinct civilization, faith, language,
and national character;

Whereas the military entry into Tibet by the People's
Republic of China in 1950 fundamentally altered the
governance of Tibet and remains the subject of enduring
international disagreement and concern;

Now, Therefore, We, Bryce L.S.P. Ivrea I, by the Grace
of God Basileus and Autokrator, do solemnly proclaim
and decree:

Article I – Recognition of Tibet

The Confederated Empire formally and perpetually
recognizes Tibet as a sovereign nation possessing the
inherent and inviolable right to determine its own
political future, free from foreign domination or coercion.

Article II – Position Concerning Tibet

The Confederated Empire condemns the military actions
undertaken by the People's Republic of China against

Tibet and expresses its support for the preservation of the Tibetan people's cultural, religious, and human rights, together with their right to determine their own future.

Article III – Friendship with the Tibetan Nation

The Imperial Crown extends its enduring friendship to the Tibetan people and affirms its hope that Tibet shall one day enjoy peace, liberty, prosperity, and the full exercise of its sovereign institutions.

Article IV – Position Regarding Taiwan

The Confederated Empire recognizes the government established upon Taiwan, officially known as the Republic of China, as the legitimate continuation of the Chinese state. Accordingly, the Empire does not recognize the People's Republic of China as the lawful government of China.

Article V – Diplomatic Policy

In accordance with this Imperial Chrysobull, the Confederated Empire withholds diplomatic recognition from the People's Republic of China. All ministries, embassies, chancelleries, and representatives of the Imperial Government shall conduct themselves in accordance with this policy until such time as another Imperial Chrysobull or Sovereign Decree shall amend or repeal it.

Article VI – Promulgation

This Imperial Chrysobull shall enter into full force immediately upon its solemn promulgation. It shall be impressed with the Great Imperial Seal, entered into the Eternal Registers of the Imperial Chancellery, communicated to all appropriate governments and authorities through the Imperial Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and shall stand among the perpetual constitutional and sovereign acts of the Confederated Empire.

Given under Our Imperial Hand and beneath the Great Imperial Seal, at the Imperial Chancellery, in the Year of Our Reign.
