SUBJECT: Opening of Formal Communications and Offer of Sovereign Friendship

Your Excellency,

I have the honor to address you in my capacity as the Grand Logothete of Foreign Relations, writing on behalf of His Imperial Majesty Bryce L.S.P. Ivrea I, Basileus and Autokrator of the Confederated Empire of Bir Tawil and Territories.

The Confederated Empire is a modern imperial institution established in 2020 upon the enduring principles of self-determination, sovereignty, and independence. In strict accordance with the standards of the 1933 Montevideo Convention on the Rights and Duties of States—which affirms that the political existence of a state is independent of recognition by other states—our nation operates under a continuous, functional constitutional framework encompassing defined sovereign claims, an active civil registry, and established state institutions.

Our sovereign domains span multiple terrestrial, maritime, and extraplanetary spheres, anchored by our baseline quadrant in the unclaimed desert region of Bir Tawil. In the interest of mutual regional alignment and history, we draw your attention to Article II of our Imperial Territorial Gazetteer, which formally incorporates the historic territories of the Viceroyalty of Yucatán. Given the close geographic, historical, and maritime proximity of the Yucatán Peninsula to the Republic of Cuba, the Empire recognizes a natural connection between our respective maritime spheres of interest.

The Confederated Empire does not engage in transient geopolitical play; rather, we actively cultivate serious, lasting diplomatic frameworks. Our Ministry of Foreign Relations maintains a documented history of formal international communication and friendship accords with distinct global bodies, including the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of China (Taiwan), the Central Tibetan Administration, and various aligned sovereign enclaves.

By order of the Imperial Chancellery, the Confederated Empire hereby extends a formal hand of sovereign friendship to the Republic of Cuba. We propose the establishment of an open, bilateral channel of communication between our ministries to discuss matters of mutual interest, maritime cartography, and future diplomatic alignment.
