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FROM THE DESK OF HIS IMPERIAL MAJESTY,

HIM EMPEROR BRYCE L.S.P. IVREA I,
Basileus and Autokrator of the Confederated Empire
and all its Sovereign Domains,
Commander of the Legions, Captain of the Molossian
Navy, Lord of Sealand, Lord of Glencoe, Defender of the
Faith, and Sovereign Grand Master of the Knights of
Napoleon.

TO THE IMPERIAL CENTURION, THE MEMBERS OF
PROJECT OSIRIS, AND ALL SERVANTS OF THE
CROWN:

GREETINGS:

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PREAMBLE: THE DUTY OF THE EXPEDITIONARY
SERVANT

WE HEREBY DECREE AND DECLARE that every
member of Project Osiris carries not only the
responsibility of exploration, but the greater
responsibility of representing the honor, dignity, and
principles of the Confederated Empire.

The Expedition shall be remembered not only for where
it travels, but for how it treats those it encounters.

The members of Project Osiris shall therefore conduct
themselves according to the ancient virtues of:

HONOR
DISCIPLINE
COURTESY
COURAGE
SERVICE

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ARTICLE I: THE FIRST COMMANDMENT OF RESPECT

The first duty of every expedition member shall be
respect toward all peoples encountered.

No member shall:

- insult or dismiss local traditions;
- disregard cultural customs;
- act with arrogance or superiority;
- represent personal opinions as official Imperial policy.

Every interaction shall begin with listening.

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ARTICLE II: THE PRINCIPLE OF FRIENDSHIP BEFORE ACTION

The Expedition shall establish relationships before
requesting cooperation.

Members shall seek to understand:

- local history;
- community concerns;

- regional challenges;
- traditional knowledge;
- hopes for the future.

Trust shall be earned through patience and honorable conduct.

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ARTICLE III: THE STANDARD OF IMPERIAL CONDUCT

All expedition members shall maintain:

1. Honorable speech.
2. Respectful behavior.
3. Clean and responsible camp practices.
4. Protection of the environment.
5. Accurate documentation of events.
6. Peaceful intentions.

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ARTICLE IV: THE COMMAND AUTHORITY OF THE IMPERIAL CENTURION

The Imperial Centurion shall maintain operational command of the Expedition.

The Centurion shall:

- enforce safety procedures;
- maintain discipline;
- preserve expedition records;
- ensure the mission remains faithful to Project Osiris.

The authority of command exists for the protection of the Expedition and the fulfillment of its peaceful mission.

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ARTICLE V: THE SACRED DUTY OF RECORD KEEPING

The Imperial Archivist shall preserve:

- expedition journals;
- maps;
- photographs;
- scientific observations;
- correspondence;
- cultural records.

The written record shall serve future generations.

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ARTICLE VI: THE OATH OF PROJECT OSIRIS

Every member shall swear:

"I shall travel with courage, speak with respect, serve with humility, and preserve the honor of Project Osiris. I shall seek friendship before ambition and understanding before judgment."
