## HHBRA NOVICE HORSE DECLARATION STATEMENT

This is a statement of eligibility for the novice horse classes in HHBRA: Circle class you are declaring. One horse per form.

\$500 Novice Pole Horse | \$500 Novice Barrel Horse

HHBRA rules state that you must know the complete total amount the horse has won in its lifetime with all riders/owners or that horse is not eligible to run in any of the HHBRA novice classes. Lifetime earnings must be less than the class limit. Please read all Novice Horse rules in the HHBRA rules.

The horse must be nominated and will accrue points for the listed rider from the date of nomination. The horse remains eligible even if there is a different rider.

If a horse is registered in any breed or color organization, you must use its registered name on this form. Nicknames may be added if desired especially if you want to run under that name. If the horse is unregistered, the owner's last name will be used as part of the horse's name. (Example: Sorrel Jones)

This is the only time you will need to report earnings for this season. A horse which is eligible at the time that the nomination is accepted by HHBRA is eligible for the entire season regardless of earnings accumulated during the season. Even though you do not report to HHBRA, please keep a personal record of any money earned. You must know the total lifetime earnings at the beginning of each year to determine if it remains within the limits of any novice class.

Remember: If you do not know the amount of earnings accumulated by this horse under all riders/owners, the horse is not eligible for any novice class. It is your responsibility to contact previous owners to discover earnings. If your horse is determined ineligible for any reason, you will be required to refund all money won in the novice class at HHBRA shows.
