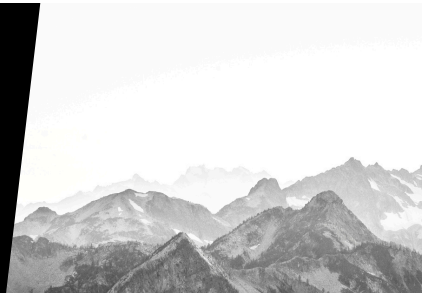




FIRST FRUITS PRAYER
