8. **Jeremiah 2:3 (NIV)**: "Israel was holy to the Lord, the first fruits of his harvest; all who devour her will be held guilty, and disaster will overtake them," declares the Lord."
9. **Ezekiel 44:30 (NIV)**: "The first of all the first fruits and all your special gifts will belong to the priests; you are to give them the first portion of your ground meal so that a blessing may rest on your household."
10. **Romans 8:23 (NIV)**: "Not only so, but we ourselves, who have the first fruits of the Spirit, groan inwardly as we wait eagerly for our adoption to sonship, the redemption of our bodies."
11. **1 Corinthians 15:20 (NIV)**: "But Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep."

12. **Revelation 14:4 (NIV)**: "These are those who did not defile themselves with women, for they remained virgins. They follow the Lamb wherever he goes. They were purchased from among mankind and offered as first fruits to God and the Lamb."
