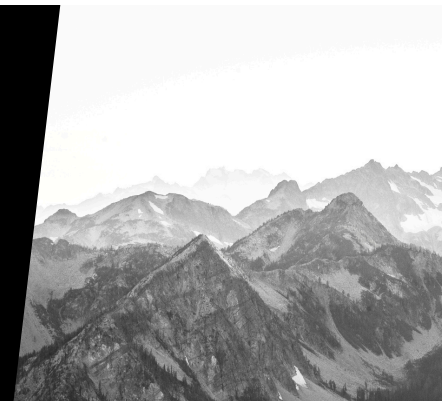




A PRAYER FOR A SACRIFICIAL OFFERING
