



A PRAYER FOR KINGDOM TIME MANAGEMENT



Heavenly Father,

I come before You, recognizing that I have fallen short in managing my time and finding rest in You. I repent for neglecting the rhythm of rest You have designed for me, failing to honor the principle of Sabbath, and allowing busyness to overtake my relationship with You (Exodus 20:8-10). I also confess any negative words I've spoken over myself or others, words that have brought discouragement instead of life (Proverbs 18:21).

Father, forgive me for being like Martha, worried and upset about many things, and missing what is most important: sitting at Your feet and abiding in Your presence (Luke 10:41-42). I repent for forgetting my identity in You and striving apart from the life-giving connection to Jesus, the true Vine (John 15:5).

Lord, I surrender my plans, my time, and my burdens to You. Help me to trust You fully and to live in the wisdom of numbering my days (Psalm 90:12). Teach me to walk wisely, making the most of every opportunity, and to work with all my heart as if serving You, not people (Ephesians 5:15-16; Colossians 3:23-24).

Renew my strength, Lord, as I place my hope in You. Help me to run and not grow weary, to walk and not faint (Isaiah 40:29-31). Teach me to trust in You with all my heart, leaning not on my own understanding, and to acknowledge You in all my ways (Proverbs 3:5-6).

Thank You, Father, for Your grace and forgiveness. I accept Your rest and peace, knowing that You love me and give me all I need for each day. Guide me to speak Your Word over my life, to bless and not curse, and to follow Your leading in every moment. In Jesus' name, Amen
