

2021 - 9th annual Arkhaios Cultural Heritage and Archaeology Film Festival

Pittsburgh, PA - Arkhaios is pleased to announce the dates of the Film Festival for 2021.

The 9th annual Arkhaios Cultural Heritage and Archaeology Film Festival will be offering the 2021 festival lineup through a secure online platform from Monday October 11 to Sunday October 17, and the Jury will announce the Arkhaios Film Festival awards winners on Saturday October 16, 5pm EST.

Arkhaios is an educational event to showcase the discovery of past cultures gained from ethnological or archaeological research, and illustrated by documentary films.

An annual event, Arkhaios takes place during Archaeology Month celebration. Normally, there are two Arkhaios events: one in South Carolina with juried competition and awards, the second in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, showing the best films from the Arkhaios Official Selection. Local gatherings are not always allowed or possible, and a Virtual Edition has been created allowing the Arkhaios audience to screen the films online.

The 2021 festival Virtual Edition will use the same Eventive platform as last year, and it will be accessed via the link <https://arkhaiosfilmfestival2021.eventive.org/welcome>, which will also be accessible from the Arkhaios website.

The Call for Film Registration has been issued to Filmmakers around the world. They can register their films until June 15, 2021. Films will compete in three categories: World Heritage, Local Heritage (SC & PA), and Underwater Archaeology.

Save the dates ! In the tradition of the Arkhaios Film Festival, the audience can anticipate to enjoy the discovery of a Rich Tapestry of World Cultures !

The multi-day Arkhaios Cultural Heritage and Archaeology Film Festival is an annual juried competition, part of Archaeology Month celebration. It is free, open to the public, and is an educational event showcasing the discovery of past cultures gained from ethnological or archaeological research and illustrated through documentary films.
