2024 - 12th annual Arkhaïos Cultural Heritage and Archaeology Film Festival Call for Film Registration

Pittsburgh, PA - The first Call for Film Registration has been issued.

Filmmakers from around the world are invited to submit their films for screening and competition consideration to the 2024 Arkhaïos Cultural Heritage and Archaeology Film Festival. The Arkhaïos Film Festival is a non-profit, educational event showcasing the discovery of past cultures gained from ethnological or archaeological research, and illustrated by documentary films. It is an international juried competition scheduled this year for October 14-20, 2024.

An annual event, Arkhaïos takes place in October, during Archaeology Month celebration. The Virtual Edition is an international online screening of all the Official Selection films participating in the juried competition. During the week of the Festival, there are several in-person Arkhaïos Festivals in the US, showing the best films from the Arkhaïos Official Selection: Florence County Museum, SC; Frick Fine Arts, University of Pittsburgh, PA; Kimbell Art Museum, Fort Worth, TX; Archaeology Museum, University of South Alabama, Mobile, AL. The film registration is for all events.
