2025 - 13th annual Arkhaiois Cultural Heritage and Archaeology Film Festival Call for Film Registration

Pittsburgh, PA - The first Call for Film Registration has been issued.

Filmmakers from around the world are invited to submit their films for screening and competition consideration to the 2025 Arkhaiois Cultural Heritage and Archaeology Film Festival. The Arkhaiois Film Festival is a non-profit, educational event showcasing the discovery of past cultures gained from ethnological or archaeological research, and illustrated by documentary films.

An annual event, Arkhaiois takes place during Archaeology Month celebration. It is an international juried competition scheduled this year for October 13-19, 2025.

The Virtual Edition is an international online screening of all the Official Selection films. During the week of the Festival, there are several in-person Arkhaiois Festivals in the US, showing the best films from the Arkhaiois Official Selections: Darlington Co. Museum, SC; Florence Co. Museum, SC; ISAC Museum, University of Chicago, IL; Kimbell Art Museum, Fort Worth, TX; Archaeology Museum, University of South Alabama, Mobile, AL. The film registration is for all events.
