Pittsburgh, PA - The second Call for Film Registration has been issued.

The film registration deadline is June 15, 2025, just six weeks away. Filmmakers and Producers will find the Registration Form along with the Rules and Regulations on the Arkhaïos Film Festival website

The films registered for the Arkhaïos Film Festival compete in the following tracks: World Heritage, Local Heritage, Underwater Archaeology, and a SHORT Films track (about 20 minutes and less).

Arkhaïos awards include the Grand Prize, Best Cultural Heritage film, Best Archaeology film, Best South Carolina Heritage film, Best Pennsylvania Heritage film, Best Underwater Archaeology film, and now Best SHORT Film, Best SHORT Cultural Heritage Film, Best SHORT Archaeology Film, Best SHORT Underwater Archaeology film.

An annual juried competition, Arkhaïos takes place in October, during Archaeology Month celebration. The Virtual Edition (October 13-19, 2025) gives a chance to screen all the films online.
