Start Towards Salvation

Start towards salvation, sounds like a misnomer. But that is really how the process works.

Read Rom. 8:24. So, we are saved by hope—something not seen.

Read Ephesians 5:1–5. I think that about covers it. But Peter doesn't.

Read 1 Peter 1:13–25; 2:1–3.

Wow! He really lays it on. Our short lives are compared to grass, temporary in terms of eternity. So we should really desire God's word. We should be hungry for it.

Once we hear or read it, we should do it. Read James 1:19–27.

The only one more plain-spoken than Paul is James. If you understood all that, you know what to do.
