

The rules for Bull Red Catch and Release category are as follows:

1. Successfully catch the bull red as described in the COFC bylaws
2. Take a picture of the fish in the boat
3. Using a measuring tape provided by COFC, measure the length of the fish from **tip of the bottom jaw to V of the fanned tail**
4. Record and take a picture of this measurement clearly showing length of fish
5. Using a measuring tape provided by COFC, measure the girth of the fish at the fattest part
6. Record and take a picture of this measurement clearly showing girth of fish
7. Member should immediately return fish to the water and attempt to revive fish
8. Bring these pictures to Cut Off Fishing Club headquarters or send them electronically to any board member

Cut Off Fishing Club will provide measuring tape.

Cut Off Fishing Club Board will determine whether all rules have been followed.

COFC Board will calculate weight of the fish by the following procedure:

Multiply girth x girth

Multiply (girth x girth) x length

Divide ((girth x girth) x length) by 800

Example: A redfish measuring 53.5” in length and 31.5” in girth would have an estimated weight of 66.35671875# or 66.36# for our yearly board.

$$31.5 \times 31.5 = 992.25.$$

$$992.25 \times 53.5 = 53085.375.$$

$$53085.375 / 800 = 66.35671875\#$$

Rounding off to hundredths place equals 66.36#
