#### AREAS OF COMPETITION

#### **Friday Night Runway Show**

This is a competition but is separate from and not included in the pageant scores. This event is scored on runway walk (or personality for our Baby Division), presence, and runway outfit.

- o Girls Show us your personality in red-carpet outfits, hi-low dresses, shorts, or pants outfits!
- Boys Show your personality! This can be anything that shows the judges who you are!
- Evening Gown/Boy's Formal Wear

20% of your score

10% of your score

#### State Pageant - Optional areas of competition - \$25 each

- Community Service
  - Create a resume, list, or scrapbook of your community service over the past two years. May include pictures.
- Role Model
  - Submit at least two letters from non-family members (teacher, youth leader, church member, coach, etc.)
     that describe how you are a role model to others. A link will be provided to upload your letters.
- Cover Model Photogenic
  - Submit 1 photogenic headshot (A link will be provided to upload your photo before the pageant.)
  - Up to 5 additional photos may be entered at \$5 each
- Photogenic Portfolio
  - Submit a portfolio of up to 10 different looks at registration
    - Please label the portfolio with the contestant's name and age division.

#### **National Pageant Information**

- All contestants that win a State Title for their Division (i.e. Teen Wisconsin Sweetheart) will advance to the National Pageant.
- The National Pageant will consist of an Evening Gown/Boys' Formal Wear and On-Stage Questions for new scores. Only Evening Gown/Formal Wear for our Baby Division.
- The National Pageant will follow the final State Pageant.
- A second Evening Gown or Formal Wear can be worn for this event but is not required.



#### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

- The Sweethearts of America Pageant will be held at two locations (2 blocks away from one another).
  - Friday Evening The Vault Banquet & Event Venue
    - The address is 625 57th Street, Kenosha, WI 53140
    - This area is restricted to street parking and a parking garage one block away, on 8th Avenue north of 57th Street.
  - Saturday The Rhode Center for the Arts
    - The address is 514 56th Street, Kenosha, WI 53140
    - There is free street and lot parking throughout Downtown Kenosha surrounding the Rhode Center, along with free public parking lots.
- Any individual attending the State and/or National Pageant will need to purchase a ticket. Each contestant will be given 1 free admission ticket. Contestants do not need tickets.
  - Tickets purchased at the door will be \$13. This money goes directly to the Rhode
     Center for the Arts Theater and to cover their taxes and fees.
- There will be a People's Choice Award. This event happens online through Pageant Planet (pageantplanet.com). Voting will begin on Monday, April 1st. Votes are \$1 each. When voting opens, you'll find links on the Sweethearts of America Facebook page. You will want to share your link with your friends and family. Encourage them to support you during your pageant weekend!
