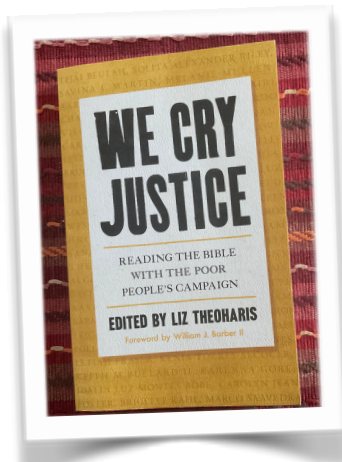


A JOURNEY TO JUSTICE

The Bible contains the word of God for both Christians and Jews. The words speak clearly to how God instructs us to approach poverty, stewardship to the earth and justice. The book “We Cry Justice” provides us an opportunity to celebrate and learn from these words.



During 2022, White Voices Against Racism (WVAR), an organization dedicated to ending systemic racism through education and the truth, is sponsoring a program called **A Journey to Justice**. Over four months, the group will lead an exploration of the book, “We Cry Justice,” with church groups and individuals who want to read the Bible along with the Poor Peoples’ Campaign and learn what the Bible says about social justice.



Editor and Contributor to “We Cry Justice,” Rev. Dr. Liz Theoharis, will guide us on our journey and provide prayer.

A JOURNEY TO JUSTICE program highlights:

- A Journey to Justice Launch via Zoom – Why and how to participate February 26, 2022 at 4 p.m.
- Weekly/monthly self-guided reading, reflection and learning with your church group or individually, through Zoom, Facebook or in person...you decide. Weekly posts by WVAR each Sunday to enhance learning and participation.
- Three Joint Discussion Events with all participants hosted by WVAR during March, April and June.
- Two tours of significant local Civil Rights sites sponsored by WVAR during July and August.
- International Civil Rights Center and Museum tour hosted by WVAR in September.

WVAR is seeking churches and individuals to participate. Fellowship Presbyterian Church is the first church to join the journey. Individual participants can sign a pledge to complete the 4-month journey. Pledging participants will be placed in a lottery to receive a free copy of “We Cry Justice” or a WVAR t-shirt.
