Join us for a viewing of the film *Bring to Light: Unveiling Truth about Human Trafficking* and discussion led by Meg Williams with AbolitionNC. *Bring to Light* is a documentary on human trafficking with a North Carolina focus. It weaves together powerful survivor stories with clear, practical guidance on how to recognize and respond to trafficking. Viewers leave with simple, actionable steps to help keep children and teens safer, especially on their electronic devices.

Meg Williams is the Director of Community Engagement at AbolitionNC. Meg's passion for fighting human trafficking is deeply rooted in her upbringing as a Quaker, a faith tradition with a long history of standing against exploitation and oppression.

Meg's commitment is shaped by personal experiences. Seeing friends foster and adopt children who had been trafficked in North Carolina opened her eyes to the urgent need for awareness and action. As a bridge builder and educator, she works tirelessly to empower individuals, organizations, and communities to join the fight against trafficking and bring hope and healing to survivors.
