2026 PAN AM ATP-CTP Pilot Training Scholarship Application**

**ONE SCHOLARSHIP for ATP-CTP training,
valued at approximately \$5000, will be awarded.**

This scholarship is for the ATP-CTP — Airline Transport Pilot Certification Training Program.

Applicants may be any female pilot with 1,100 or more hours of flight time.

Applications are due by 11:59 p.m. EST on July 15, 2026.

Scholarship recipients must complete the training funded by this scholarship by **July 15, 2027.**

ABOUT THE PAN AM ATP-CTP PILOT TRAINING COURSE

The PAN AM ATP-CTP Pilot Training Course is a stand-alone prerequisite for the ATP written exam. It meets all FAA 14 CFR 61.156 requirements. It is **not** a type rating.

The ATP-CTP course includes:

- 30 hours of classroom instruction.
- 4 hours of training in a fixed-base simulator.
- 6 hours of training in a full-motion flight simulator.

This scholarship covers the full cost of tuition for the training. Please note that lodging, transportation, meals, and any associated FAA fees are **not included** and will remain the responsibility of the recipient.

At PAN AM Flight Academy, classes are offered weekly at the Miami location.

The recipient must understand that this is a pilot-training-only scholarship. There will be no cash award in lieu of the training.

ESSAY REQUIREMENT

Attach a one-page essay, single-spaced, using 12-point font and 1-inch margins. The essay should include the following:

- What sparked your interest in flying.
- Proposed use of the scholarship.
- How you will fund the balance of your training.
- Your ultimate aviation goal.
- The type of flying you have done or plan to do.
- Other aviation experience or training.
- Education and background.
- Your contributions to The Ninety-Nines or the aviation community.
- What special qualities, aviation-related or otherwise, make you an exceptional candidate for this scholarship.
- Any other information that may be helpful to the Scholarship Committee in making its decision.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

1. Attach copies of the following:
 - All pilot certificates, front and back.
 - Current FAA medical certificate.
 - Last 14 logbook entries, electronic copies acceptable, or the last two pages of your logbook with all columns totaled and all pages signed.
 - Ground school or written test results for the requested certificate or rating.
 - Any endorsements, such as Flight Review, WINGS, etc.
 - Personal resumé.
2. Letters of Recommendation

Attach two current letters of recommendation. One should be professional, and the second may be from a professional or personal contact.

Suggested references include: Flight instructor who has recently flown with you, Ninety-Nines member, Employer, FAA representative, Local pilot organization member, AOPA member, EAA member, Member of an organization with which you volunteer.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The recipient of the 2026 Florida Goldcoast Chapter of The Ninety-Nines PAN AM ATP-CTP Pilot Training Scholarship will be selected by a committee consisting of judges active in aviation. The decision of the Scholarship Committee is final. If no qualified applicant applies, the Scholarship Committee reserves the right to withhold the scholarship.

Applications will be judged with priority given, in no particular order, to the following:

- Neatness.
- Attention to detail and completeness of the application package.
- Compelling personal story and clearly stated aviation goals.
- Likelihood of success in reaching stated goals.
- Ability to serve as an ambassador representing women in aviation.
- Participation in and promotion of The Ninety-Nines, aviation events, and aviation activities after achieving aviation goals.

- Demonstration of financial need.
- Recommendations addressing professional and personal attributes.

DISBURSEMENT

- The scholarship recipient will receive a PAN AM gift certificate at a FL Goldcoast 99s meeting to use when her schedule allows.
- The recipient must complete the training funded by this scholarship by **July 15, 2027**.
- After completing the training, the recipient must submit a final report to Scholarship Trustee Jen Toplak by email at jen.toplak@gmail.com.

SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT REQUIREMENTS

The scholarship recipient will be required to:

- Attend the Florida Goldcoast 99s Holiday Scholarship Luncheon in December.
- Submit a photo of herself with an airplane for use on Florida Goldcoast 99s social media and in *The Ninety-Nines News Magazine*. The photo should be emailed to Jen Toplak at jen.toplak@gmail.com.
- Submit progress updates every 60 days to Jen Toplak at jen.toplak@gmail.com.
- Complete the training funded by this scholarship by **July 15, 2027**.
- Submit a final report to Jen Toplak at jen.toplak@gmail.com.
- Attend a Florida Goldcoast 99s meeting to share her accomplishments and discuss how this scholarship helped her achieve her goals.
