

**TEAM RUBICON** serves communities by mobilizing veterans to continue their service by leveraging their skills and experience to help people prepare, respond, and recover from disasters and humanitarian crises. Founded following the Haiti earthquake in 2010, the organization has grown to over 150,000 volunteers across the United States and has launched nearly 1,000 operations both domestically and internationally. Amidst the COVID-19 outbreak, Team Rubicon not only pivoted to be able to continue to deliver disaster response and rebuild services in core mission areas but also expanded their scope of missions to meet community needs brought about by COVID. As a founding member of the Veterans Coalition for Vaccination (VCV), Team Rubicon has supported the distribution of over 1.6 million COVID-19 vaccinations in more than 105 cities across the United States and Puerto Rico. This year, Team Rubicon's medical volunteers returned to Haiti to respond to the devastating earthquake, providing medical assistance and patient care to over 1,700 people. Simultaneously, Team Rubicon also launched a major response to Hurricane Ida, a Category 4 storm devastating communities along the Gulf Coast and many southeast and northeast states. Since starting the response, Team Rubicon has assisted homeowners with muck-outs, roof tarping, and removal of downed trees and debris from over 450 homes across five Louisiana Parishes and two cities in the northeast. Most recently, Team Rubicon has been assisting in all phases of welcoming Afghan families into communities across the United States. The organization is managing donated goods at six bases across the country, supporting site logistics for new arrivals, and setting up housing units as families transition into communities.
