Staff and volunteers work one-on-one with our service members, veterans, and military familiesproviding ongoing support for as long as legitimate needs require. Experienced at anticipating needs, our case managers often introduce new programs

assistance and lifetime support to our nation's critically wounded, ill, and injured service

to further assist service members and military families throughout the journey to recovery and transition back into their communities. The Fund can process, on average, over 130 grant requests each day. We typically deliver assistance within 24-48 hours of receiving an emergency request, and within a week for non-urgent cases.

OUR MISSION IS CRITICAL. OUR DUTY IS CLEAR. We apply donations to comprehensive, innovative, and proven programs that deliver immediate and long-lasting impact. Our promise is heartfelt and lifelong: The Fund ensures that service members and military families have the resources they need during their recovery and throughout transition back
